Run The Universe! ----->>

The Angkor Wat International Half Marathon is an international charity event that has been running since 1996 for the benefit of land-mine victims and other pressing issues in Cambodian development. The event is held at a location designated by UNESCO as a World Heritage Site, Angkor Wat, one of the wonders of the world with fantastic views, historical temples, jungle and water-falls.

Angkor Wat is the ultimate step pyramid temple, representing the magic mountain of Hindu mythology, surrounded by its universe and oceans. The complex of temples, hidden in tropical jungle, is spread out over hundreds of hectares.

Angkor Wat is located in Siem Reap province 314km from Phnom Penh. It can be reached by air from Phnom Penh in 45 minutes. International air lines also operate direct flights from Thailand, Vietnam, Singapore and five other routes. Regular air-conditioned buses also operate from Phnom Penh, taking around 5 hours.



Angkor Wat(1113-1150) ----->>

Angkor Wat was built by Sur-yavarman II during the first half of the 12th Century. It is the funeral pyre dedicated to Vishnu. Two nagas line a 200m long sand stone alley across the moat. The around the temple is 190m wide and 5.5km long.



Ta Prohm(1186) ----->>

The temple was built by Jayavarman VII and dedicated to his mother. It is one of the most fascinating of all the temples. Invaded by the roots of giant banyan trees, the temple fights a slow battle with nature.



Angkor Thom(1190-1210) ----->>

Angkor Thom is in fact a city (the Great City). The enclosure is a large square area, 3km long on each side. A 100m wide moat surrounds the city. Jayavarman VII built the complex on the ruined city once controlled by Udayadityavarman II (1050 – 1066). The Bayon Temple stands at the centre of the city.

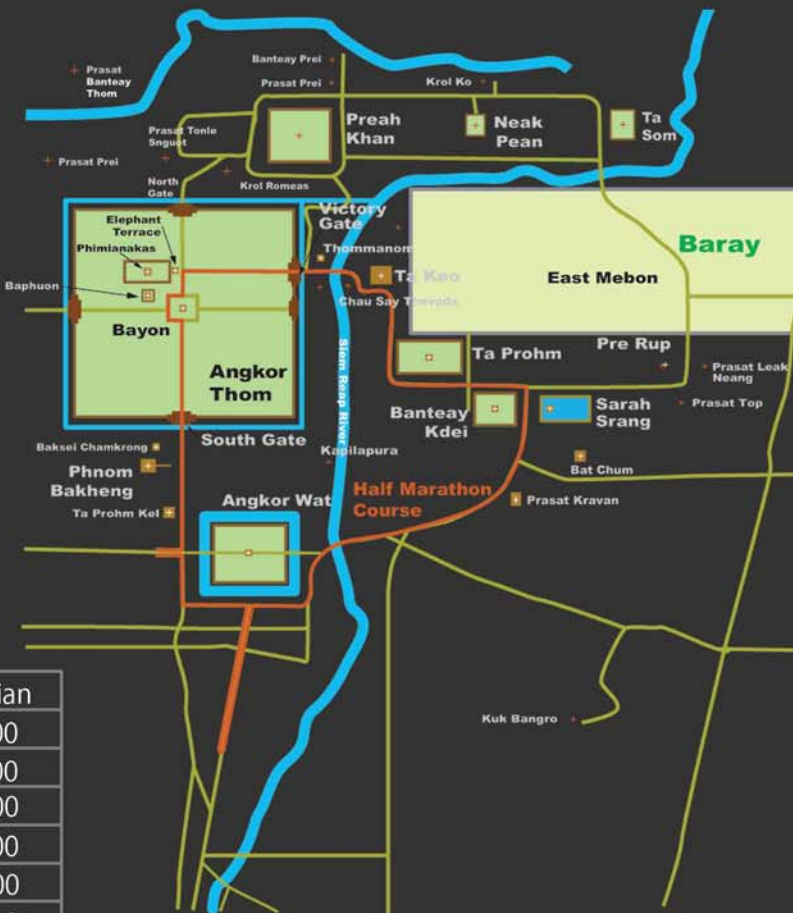
